What is the “Fun in the Sun” contest?

It’s a summer reading contest open to Campbell-Savona students entering grades 7-12 for the 2009-2010 school year. It will run from June 5th-September 10th.

What could we win?

Possible prizes may include: a mini notebook/laptop, digital camera, mp3 player, gift cards for local retailers, etc.

Do I have to participate?

NO! This is a 100% voluntary contest.

What do I have to do to participate?

For each book that you read over the summer, complete an entry form and submit it to Mrs. Balliett in the high school library. Entry forms can be mailed to Mrs. Balliett throughout the summer, or you can drop them off in person in the library throughout the summer, or you can bring your forms with you to the first week of school and you can drop them off in the library by **Thursday, September 10th**. You can pick up additional entry forms at the front desk in the library, in the main office, the guidance office, or online at www.cscsd.org.

Wait, so the high school library is going to be open this summer?

That’s right! Mrs. Balliett has offered to keep the library open during the **morning summer school hours in July** so that you can come in and check out books.

What if I don’t like reading traditional chapter books?

The “Fun in the Sun” contest is all about encouraging students to read more of whatever type of literature YOU enjoy. So if you prefer magazines, you can read 4 magazines (cover-to-cover) to equal one grade-level, chapter book and complete one entry form for the four magazines you read. We are also accepting graphic novels and eBooks.

What is the catch?

Here are a few rules you need to keep in mind:

- Books must be age and grade-level appropriate
- You cannot submit an entry form for a book that you have previously received credit for in an ELA class or for independent reading
- You and your parent or guardian must complete the Academic Honesty portion of the form or they will not be accepted

How will we know if we have won?

All participants will be invited to an event in the library during the month of September. At that time participants will receive a ticket for each entry form they submitted. Participants will then be able to enter their tickets in a drawing for the prize(s) of their choice. All participants will be automatically entered to a win a Grand Prize.
