Dear Students, Families and Community Members,

Today is the end of our first week of an emergency dismissal due to the coronavirus pandemic in our state and country. And I would like to update the C-S community in regards to the most recent information we have from county and state authorities. Included below are also reminders about the supports the District has put in place to help students and families during this school closure.

**Most recent information from Steuben County and New York State:**

Steuben County posted today on the county's official website that, as of this writing, there have been two confirmed cases in the county. That information is likely to change and I encourage you to monitor the Steuben County website for the most current information:

Governor Cuomo announced earlier today that as of Monday March 23 only essential workers in the state are to report to work. This step is being taken to limit social contact, and therefore the spread of this virus. A list of essential workers can be found at:

Now that the coronavirus has reached our county, I urge you and your family members to stay home as much as possible and keep a safe distance from others in public. "Social Distancing" is an effective way to help keep your family healthy and to slow the spread of Coronavirus.

**District support plans for students and families:**

Our teachers, counselors and administrators worked hard and on an unbelievably short timeline to put together learning packets for students. And our students and families were awesome in their response!

100% of our students/families made it a priority to pick up materials at school or worked out arrangements to have materials sent to their homes. Students now have the materials and suggestions necessary to keep them focused on their learning through April 10.

We are also providing breakfast and lunch for all students, 18 years of age or younger, Monday through Friday. Meals can be picked up at both of our schools or at the Thurston Town Hall or the Sonora Pit Stop on Route 226. More specific information is posted on our website and attached to this letter. I do encourage you to continue to monitor the website as delivery locations and procedures may change.

Childcare referral help for parents in "essential professions" is also available through Proaction of Steuben and Yates County.
